2. Location of competition

3. General Information

The rules and regulations (WB and RO) of the German Swimming Federation (DSV) and the anti-doping regulations will be in full force during the competitions. For handicapped swimmers with the appropriate classification of evidence the rules and regulations of the German Disabled Sports Federation (DBS) will be in force additionally. The one-start-rule will apply – no false start.

4. Participation and take-off permission

The competition is open to members of clubs or teams which belong to a DSV associated federation. The competition is also open to all foreign members of clubs or teams as far as their national federations are FINA's members and are entitled to compete.

Clubs and teams, which belong to a DSV associated federation have to be careful: The competition is open only to swimmers who are registered at DSV and the annual license fee according to § 16 Pt. 2 (f) of EUR 15, - € is paid. This is to insure by sending the entries according to § 12 Pt. 1 (WB of DSV).

5. Specification of the pool

The swimming pool is 50 m long with 10 lanes, divided by wavebreaking ropes. Competitors can use the pool for warming up until 10 minutes prior to the competition. The depth of the pool is 3.00 metres at all points. Water's temperature is 27°C. Automatic measuring will be in use.

6. Panel of judges

The judges will be supplied by the Berliner Schwimm-Verband (BSV).

7. Seeding of heats / pre.-heats and final heats

All races will be swum in 10 lanes. The preliminary heats will be set and timed by international rules without consideration of age groups and ranking. In all other heats the seeding of the lanes will be decided by the registration or qualification times, again without consideration of age groups. The fastest race will be swum last. Setting of two swimmers in a lane is not allowed. The organizer reserves to himself to fill up vacant lanes.

8. Limitations

8.1. Limitations - heats

In case of problems with time schedule the organizer reserves to himself to limit the number of entries on principle. The limitation should be done within a maximum number of heats depending to the distances. See the list below. According to this surplus entries will rejected with priority to the distances of 200m and higher. The approved entries of a competition will be divided equally among the respective age groups, depending on the entry time. That means, the fastest entries of the respective age group take priority. Even entries within the standard times and faster will be included in case to a necessary limitation procedure.

The clubs will be informed about rejected entries with their official confirmation (see 13.1).

8.2. General limitation - complete competition

The organizer reserves to himself in case of far beyond the competition frame incoming entries, to close the acceptance of entries already earlier than final entry date. The order of rank of the incoming registrations is crucial. The announcement of such an action takes place simultaneously at the ISM-homepage.

9. Final heats qualification

- Finals 50m races: The 10 fastest swimmers of each age group will be qualified to the corresponding final heat.
- Finals 100m races, open group: The 10 fastest swimmers of **all** age groups will be qualified to the open group final heat.
- Finals 100m races, EJC-and-younger group: **From the remaining participants** of the EJC-and-younger age group the next 10 fastest swimmers are the cast of the final heat.

Valid for all finals: In case of qualified swimmers scratch their final entry in time, there are three reserve swimmers nominated for moving up to the final heat. The number of scratches decide the number of the moved up swimmers. If more than 10 swimmers are qualified for a final heat because they are swum the same time, the panel of judges decides the final participation by drawing lots.

10. Enrollment / sending registrations

Each club has to send its entries separately and leave separately from other clubs. Registrations must be send **by email**. For registering your entries you can use the forms attached to this invitation or use the downloadable forms on the ISM website. Also possible are the DSV-forms no. 109 and 102. In case of sending registrations with datafile (german DSV-Standard, Lenex) **there must be attached additionally the both forms as above explained as file.**

The clubs and teams have to **make sure their own contact's data validity**. Registrations sent by email are only valid with an organizer's receiving-confirmation to the sender.

Entries will be rejected or can not be accepted if

- they are incomplete (e. g. missing or incorrect years, incorrect gender, ...)
- they are illegible
- no entry times are declared
- they are demonstrably incorrect
- the clubs contact data are missing or incomplete
- with unclear processes, the registering club can not be contacted promptly by e-mail

Each team has to include to the entry list the number of athletes, also the number of team companions according to item 14.2.

11. Final Entry Date (Deadline)

Wednesday, February 19, 2014
6.00 o'clock p.m. CET

Later incoming entries can not be considered. The acceptance of entries can be closed exceptionally earlier in case of far beyond the competition frame incoming entries. See item 8.2.

12. Entry fee

The entry fee is 11,00 Euro per person and each start and 20,00 Euro per relay start (s. 18.). By reaching the requiring times (standard times) 3,00 Euro will be repaid.¹ The entry fee payment has to be made at arrival by cash before the first start in the Check-In (accreditation). A non-cash payment (eg banker's card) is not possible at the venue. Alternative you can transfer the entry fee to the following banking account:

Important: The transfer has to be made so early, that the transfer is by competition's beginning completed and the fee is verifiably credited to organizers account.

Already paid fee for possibly rejected entries according to point 8. will be repaid. Refunds of entry fees for reaching standard times will be done by the organizer by banking transfer if the club has a banking account in the EU area. If the club can not name any banking account in the EU area, there is the possibility of credit's repayment in cash. This can be done earliest after the end of the fourth session on competitions last day. **It is recommended already by sending the entries to name a valid international SEPA banking account (complete with the payee's name, IBAN and BIC).** If these SEPA-Data are not available on March 9, 2014 at latest, the right to a refund of the credit expires. The entry fee will not be refunded due to scratches by the club after final entry date, swimmer's absence or disqualification in the race.

13. Enrollments procedure

13.1. Confirmation of receipt

Each participating club will receive a confirmation of receipt of its entries until 6 hours latest after deadline. If the club have

up to this point, no or an incorrect confirmation of receipt, the club has to complain about this until 9 o'clock latest of the following day to the organizer. Complaints received after this will not be considered.

13.2. Official confirmation

The sending of the official registration confirmation will happen not earlier than 24 hours after the deadline. It contains information about approved or rejected entries. Complaints thereto must be notified within 24 hours after receiving to the organizer. Any complaints received after this point of time can not be considered.

Any necessary changes from this enrollment procedure will be posted on the ISM website.

14. Organization

14.1. Common

Before competition's beginning each team will receive all relevant documents, for example, the start lists, clubcard and the participants cards in the Check-In by showing their entries confirmation. The entry fee payment confirmation of the bank must be shown in case of necessity at the Check-In. The Check-In is located in the entrance area of the swimming hall. Informations about ISM are also available and given due notice on the meeting homepage www.ism-germany.com.

14.2. Team's companions (Coaches, assistants, physios ...)

The total authorized number of team companions based on the number of athletes. For the first five athletes two companions cards are provided. For every fraction of a further five athletes increases the number of companion cards to each one. The supervision of the athletes during warm-up and s.o. have to do the companions.

14.3. Visa affairs

Teams which are in need for visa to enter Germany for participating at ISM are recommended to make a contact with their competent authorities and ISM's organizer. This should be done 6 weeks at the latest before final entry date (that means mid January 2014).

15. Age groups

15.1. Age groups single

The following age groups will be used as in the order of competition listed:

¹ Different arrangements for participating clubs from Berlin: With the submission of their entries are to be paid eight euros per individual entry. For each start which is not reaching the requiring standard times the clubs have to pay three euros after the meeting.

15.2. Age groups for the 100m-distances

- Preliminary heats: The age groups **EYOF and Youngsters** will be decided in preliminary heats.
- Finals: In the finals of the open group decisions will happen independent of of age groups
- In the final heats summary of the EJC-and-younger age-groups, the participants of the final in the open group will be included in case of they are belonging to the EJC-and-younger age groups. The complete summary is based on the times are swum.

15.3. Age groups teams

The scoring of teams includes all placements 1-10 of the age group accordingly to item 15.1. **only of the preliminary and deciding races** (no final placements). The placements 1-10 are assessed according to the following points allocation:

1. Pl. = 11 points, 2. Pl. = 9 points, 3. Pl. = 8 points, ... and so on to 10. Pl. = 1 point.

The addition of all reached points of each team will be done for the following team scoring groups:

- *open group male and female together*
- *Youth (EJC, EYOF) male and female together*
- *Youngsters male and female together*

16. Prizes

16.1. Prizes in single age groups

In the final heats will receive

- places 1-10 of each age group: certificates
- places 1-3 of each age group: medals or special awards

In all **deciding races and the 100m-decisions in the preliminary heats** (15.2.) will receive

- *Places 1-3 of the age groups Open, EJC, EYOF:* certificates
- *Places 1-8 of the age group Youngsters:* certificates
- *Places 1-3 of each age group:* medals or special awards

The winners of the **100m-Final heats** will receive

- *Open group* Prizes worth 100,-- Euro
- *EJC and younger* Prizes worth 70,-- Euro

The winners of the **50m-Final heats** will receive according the following age groups:

- *Open group* Prizes worth 70,-- Euro
- *EJC* Prizes worth 40,-- Euro
- *EYOF* Prizes worth 40,-- Euro
- *Youngsters I* Prizes worth 20,-- Euro
- *Youngsters II* Prizes worth 20,-- Euro

The 6 absolutely best results in points (valid DSV-comparative performance table swimming¹) will get (only one swimmer in one score) the following prizes

- *1st Place male:* 500,-- Euro
- *1st Place female:* 500,-- Euro
- *2nd Place male* 250,-- Euro
- *2nd Place female:* 250,-- Euro
- *3rd Place male:* 200,-- Euro
- *3rd Place female:* 200,-- Euro
- *4th Place male:* 125,-- Euro
- *4th Place female:* 125,-- Euro

- *5th Place male:* 75,-- Euro
- *5th Place female:* 75,-- Euro
- *6th Place male:* 50,-- Euro
- *6th Place female:* 50,-- Euro

16.2. Prizes in team age groups

The best team in points according to the ranking of teams will get in

- *open group male and female together*
ISM-Team cup open group
- *Youth (EJC, EYOF) male and female together*
ISM-Team cup youth
- *Youngsters male and female together*
ISM-Team cup children

16.3. Special prizes

For a new **World Record** (open group) the swimmer will receive a

- Prize 2.000,-- Euro

For a new **European Record** (open group) the swimmer will receive a

- Prize 1.000,-- Euro

If there will be swum several similar records during ISM 2014, the swimmer of the record with the best result in points (valid DSV-Comparative performance table Swimming) will receive the money cash prize.

The organizer reserves to himself to award another special prizes. This is valid for awarding of all prizes: If more swimmers have equal placements, prizes will be shared in equal amount to the swimmers.

17. Victory ceremony

The victory ceremony is part of the competition. Prizes and awards (certificates, medals and cups) will not be sent on.

18. KnockOut-Relays

In sessions 2, 3 and 5 freestyle relay races (4x50m) take place on the following principle:

- preliminary round 4 heats in session 2 (Ev 50)
- interim round 2 heats in session 3 (Ev 150)
- final round 1 heat in session 5 (Ev 250)

The relays must be swum with 2 male and 2 female swimmers, which can be arbitrarily changed from round to round. The relay entries must be submitted with entry times for the preliminary round in Ev 50. The fastest 40 relays (entry times) will be approved. The entry fee for the relays is 20 €.

All heats of the preliminary and intermediate round are set and timed to international rules (according to the principle preliminary heats).

The **5 time-fastest teams of each heat** qualify itself for the respective next round.

If less than 21 teams should enter the relay races, then the preliminary round (Ev 50) is void.

The relay appointment of swimmers must be delivered at the beginning of each round to the competition management.

The three best teams in the finals will receive

- **medals and cups.**
- **prize worth 500,-- Euro.**

The results of the relay races are not calculated in the team-scoring (15.3.).

19. Miscellaneous

19.1. Internet
